5:50pm to 6:00pm	<p><u>SB's NVQ Project Booklet for feedback:</u> As part of her NVQ qualification, Sherie (UVP Apprentice) has to do a project to show some of the skills she has learnt. She decided to make a booklet called 'Projects/Disorders and where Surrey young people can get support'. This includes 2 phobias and 2 disorders that she feels could be detrimental to YP's lives and it is important that they know what support is out there for them. Sherie has come to CYA Staines for feedback on the 1st draft, but now it's 2nd draft time!</p>
6:00pm to 6:20pm	<p><u>Surrey County Council Practise Standards Review:</u> Surrey County Council are looking to get views and opinions of children and young people of their practice standards that are being updated. These practice standards support social workers, family support workers, youth workers and other practitioners to work with families, children and young people in a way that is respectful, non-judgemental and consistent. The practice standards need to cover areas of policy but they also want them to be visually appealing and accessible to children, young people and families. They want to be able to support workers through these practice standards to provide clear understanding of what is expected of them, so that the service families receive improves and is consistent.</p>



	<p>In the current practice standards there are Top 10 must do's when working with children and young people. Care Council developed a list of top 10 must do's for Surrey County Staff which have been integral to our practice standards. These were created in 2019.</p> <p>They would like to know from CYA, do you agree with these top 10 must do's? Would you like to change or add anything else? Or alternatively do you think there is another way young peoples' views can be incorporated into Surrey's Practice Standards? For example, something similar to the UVP Guarantee's you created with us? 6:30pm-6:55pm	<p><u>Part 1 - Time to Change:</u> Time to Change supports voluntary organisations and charities across Surrey to recruit more young people (19-25) as volunteers. They provide training for organisations to support them to develop their recruitment process and strategy to make their organisation and volunteer roles more appealing and attractive to young people, resulting in more young people aged 19-25 volunteering at these organisations. In addition, they are setting up a focus group made up of Volunteering Ambassadors aged 19-25. They will gain their opinions a variety of topics around volunteering and young people and this insight will be used to inform voluntary organisations and charities.</p> <p><u>Part 2 – Time to Change:</u> They are also trying to create some video content of young people talking about why they volunteer, the benefits of volunteering etc. which will be used on social media channels to encourage other young people to volunteer.
